Karin Schulz is an artist who has combined the art of making unique hand bound books with digital imaging. She has studied with numerous artists and won a number of awards for her paintings and graphics. In addition to her own Blue Garden Press in Menlo Park, she has exhibited her work at many shows worldwide and assisted in teaching courses in printmaking at the College of San Mateo and Foothills College and the Adobe Photoshop workshop at the Palo Alto Art Center.

Karin was born and raised in southern Florida. She received a Bach. of Science from Purdue University and taught math and science. Her serious art endeavors began as soon as her children were in school. An interest in digital imaging developed about 7- 8 years ago when a friend introduced her to the possibilities of combining her art interests with the capabilities of the computer and Photoshop. She will discuss some of her Photoshop techniques and exhibit a number of the books she has created.

Photoshop CS2 Trial version problem

If anyone **downloaded** the free trial version of Photoshop CS2 from Adobe's website, it comes in a .zip file and **must be extracted before you try to install it**. If you try to install it directly from the ZIP archive, it will require a serial number before it will install. The same is true for other Adobe trial programs such as InDesign or Illustrator. If you are using a copy of the trial CD from the Photoshop users meeting, there should be no problem.
